Green Gold (DS) w  
Indian Yellow (AS) w  
Mineral Violet (HB) c  
Paynes Gray (WN) n + Indigo Blue (WN) w = BLACK  
Compose Green (HB) w, creamy  
Quin. Burnt Scarlet 9AKA Lucky Penny (AJ)
